Merry Christmas and Happy New Year from Dave Lann, Lay Director, VdC of Ohio

Greetings Via de Christo community. We hope you enjoyed a wonderful holiday season. This time of year can be a struggle for many because of the past, financial struggles, loss of loved ones or just tired of all the secular spirit of the season. As long as we keep our focus on the reason for the season, the birth of our Savior, no matter what we go through our Lord is there with us to see us through our trials and be at our side in our daily walk with Him. With this new year, the **first event will be the Clergy event** on **Sunday evening February 24** till just after supper **Monday the 25**. On Sunday evening we will have a social, introduce them to what Via de Cristo is, the history of VdC, and have evening meditations followed by silence. The next morning, we'll have worship followed by introductions with assigned table seating. We will go over each of the talks with information that is in the VdC Team Formation Manual. As I stated in the November Newsletter, we will be asking you to choose prayer times to cover this event just like a normal Weekend. Look for it next month.

To make this happen we need your help. Along with this article you will see an invitation form. Copy it and give to your pastors and invite them if they do not know what VdC is or know only a little of it. Even if your pastor has gone before, we all have family members and friends who attend other churches; please invite their clergy. This event is open to all clergy.

For our clergy who have been to a VdC Weekend, please invite your colleagues; e-mail them the invitation. If we all do something this will be a huge success for the glory of our God.

The last thing we want to leave you with is the **Coed Weekend, May 30th through June 2**. After recent events, the Secretariat made a decision that if we do not have a required number of pilgrims in the registrar's hand two months before the scheduled Weekend dates, we will not go forward with that Weekend. Anyone who is registered for it will be at top of list for next scheduled Weekend. With the cost of the weekends we need to be good stewards of our money, time (team will be formed but not have any meetings till we have pilgrims) and talent (your palanca so we have time to pray for individuals and create personal palanca). Most of the facilities will give a full refund in this time period. We are still discussing the number of pilgrims needed to make it effective for what Via de Cristo is about.
