Hello 4th day community,

This is an update on the events that I have mentioned in the previous newsletters.

Now that you have access to the flyer (attached) to invite pastors to the Clergy event, give the flyer to clergy whom you know so we may introduce Via de Cristo to them and respond to their perceptions of what it is. Ask them to register so Christy and I can get their information about health or food restrictions for the camp.

The second part of this is the Prayer Palanca times. Attached to this newsletter you should find prayer times for every half hour for Sunday February 24 from 7:00 pm until Monday February 25 at 7:00 pm. We will be happy for several people to sign up for each slot. When it gets closer, we will send out any open time slots. The next thing is our Annual Picnic. It will still be at Mt. Gilead State Park, but instead of Saturday June 22nd it will be June 29. Our time is still to be determined, most likely around noon.

The last thing I will leave you with is the Weekends. In the last newsletter, I told you that 2 months before the scheduled date of any Weekend we need to have a required number of applications in the Registrar's hand. After two meetings worth of discussing this topic, Secretariat agreed that number will be 8 pilgrims. We will still take more applications for other people until one week before the Weekend begins or until we are full, depending on the capacity of the location. This means for the Co-ed Weekend we need to have 8 applications in Kevin's hand by March 30. If we don't have the 8 the Weekend will be canceled, and the applications on hand will be first in line for the next appropriate weekend (Coed, Men's or Women's, depending on the applicant).

So, pray about whom to ask and approach their pastor to make sure they are fully capable to participate. Then approach the Pilgrims with the guidance of the Holy Spirit. Make them aware that the Weekend is a short course of study in Christian discipleship and that we need to have at least 8 to make it work. Then get the paperwork in to Registrar Kevin Hoch as soon as possible. Send registrations to him at 2691 Alturia Dr., Cincinnati 45239. (See attached forms.)

Christ is counting on us to develop Christian leaders to go into our environments to do his work.
