Hello 4th day community,

March 30th is approaching us very quickly. Why is that important? With the new guidelines set for the Weekends, that is the date we need to have at least 8 applications for Pilgrims in Registrar Kevin Hoch's hands. This does not mean in your hands or the mail. This is the latest we can go to get a full refund from the site of the Weekend, and before any team meetings are started. We'll continue taking applications after that date.

As far as the Rector for Coed # 4, it is Christy Brill. She is presently forming the Team. One thing I like about team info not out yet is that lately it has been the Team getting the majority of Pilgrims. Christ is counting on us as a Community to provide the Pilgrims. The team has enough to do to bond together than to worry about getting Pilgrims. Make sure you inform your Pilgrim that this is a highly structured Weekend, so they understand we need 8 pilgrims to accomplish this and make it beneficial for them. If we do not have 8 by March 30 in order to proceed with this Weekend, their names are at the top of the list for next available Weekends. Please know that **we will continue to take applications for Pilgrims after March 30** until the deadline of Thursday May 23, allowing a week to do necessary communication with the Pilgrims!

Remember that we are looking for leaders in our environments (work, recreation, social, family, etc.) not just our churches.

A Letter from Christy Brill, Rector for VdC Ohio Co-ed Weekend #4

I'm honored and humbled to be the rector of Co-Ed Weekend #4 being held at Saints Peter and Paul Retreat Center in Newark this Spring, May 30 -- June 2. It has been nearly 15 years since I served as rector of Women's #53 at the Cum Cristo Center in downtown Columbus and over 20 years since I attended Women's #36 where I was first introduced to this thing we call Via de Cristo of Ohio. During this time, I have been fortunate enough to have served on 14 different teams as well as share the Fourth Day talk 4 times. Currently I serve on the Secretariat as the Assistant Lay Director and Media Technology Chair. I don't mention this information to brag, but to let you know how much this movement means to me.

Via de Cristo was recommended to me in a time in my life when I was coming back to the Church and trying to make my faith my own (not just that which I grew up hearing). Although I was probably more of the one who thought she needed it the least on that Weekend in 2005, I became more aware of the need and desire to serve our Lord as I began to work on teams. As you know, not everyone has a mountain top experience on their weekends; some of us need time for the information shared during that 72-hours to seep in and permeate our souls. That was me.

Today, I learned of the passing of my dear friend and early spiritual advisor Rev. Jim Stalder. He and his wife Wanda (who died in April 2012) were instrumental in my faith-walk after my weekend (as were my sponsors, Doug & Kathie Burrows). Both were avid supporters of Via de Cristo and made sure that I stayed in Reunion Group and that our congregation at the time knew of the importance of the 4th Day. They not only talked the talk but walked the walk. They are but a couple of the wonderful, Christ-loving people that I have grown to know and love thanks to my involvement in Via de Cristo, and they along with so many others will be and are deeply missed as they leave beautiful marks on the lives of so many Cursillistas.

So why do I share the above stories? Because I have a feeling you have a similar one that needs to be shared with someone around you. Look back on your weekend. What was the ONE thing that stands out to you from that time? Do you have a special memory that makes you smile (or cry tears of joy) when you think of that specific Rollo that hit you to the core and somehow you just knew that God was talking to you? How about that song that when sung at your church or a funeral takes you right back to those total strangers that interrupted your dinner on Saturday night? Do you ever wonder about those brothers/sisters that sat at your table with whom you shared stories and drew pictures? Whom do you know who can benefit from the grace-filled time of a Via de Cristo weekend? I'm sure there is at least one.

Currently I'm in the process of calling and filling the team for Co-Ed #4. As I type this letter, there are eight people committed to serve, but I need a minimum of twenty to have a successful weekend. If you are interested in working the team, please reach out to me or Head Cha Dick Brenneman. And if you haven't attended Leader's School yet or haven't

been on a team in a while, that's ok because we are incorporating that training into the first team meeting! Worried that you will waste a bunch of Saturdays in April and May just to have the Weekend cancelled? Fear not, our first team meeting is not scheduled until after the March 30 early registration deadline when we need to have 8 registrations, or the Weekend will be postponed (we currently have 1).

Team meeting dates are: April 6, April 27, May 11 and May 18.

So what's your excuse? Volunteer to serve, ask a friend to attend, or sign up to pray for weekend. And the sooner, the better.
