Hello Community,

This is to inform you that we have reached capacity for women for the Coed # 4 Weekend. We still have a few spots available for men. But do not let that discourage you from sending in applications. If anyone drops from the Weekend the next person on the list will be asked to fill the spot so we remain at capacity. The ones still on the list will be first in line for the next Weekend available (Women's, Coed or Men's, depending on applicant.) This is actually a good problem to have if we have a waiting list. Pray for the Pilgrims and all involved on the Team. If you can, be sure to send Palanca, attend Send-off, join the Serenade or attend the Closing. Community is what makes Via de Cristo thrive.

With the summer months approaching us, do not forget to get applications in to Registrar Kevin Hoch for the fall Weekends. The Women's Weekend is October 3 - 6. The Men's is November 7 - 10. They will be at the Akron Rotary Club. The cutoff date to have at least 8 pilgrims is August 3 for the women and September 7 for the men. I would guess the capacity for this facility will be between 18 and 24.

The Clergy event is scheduled for July 14 -15. There is a flyer attached with this Newsletter to copy or send to a clergy person whom you know who hasn't been on a Weekend. This does not replace the Weekend, but it's more to introduce them to a VdC Weekend so they have a better understanding of what it is. From there they can decide to do a full Weekend or at least know what it is to send people from their congregations. It will still be at Camp Mowana on the north side of Mansfield in their Fleming Falls retreat center.

Last thing is the Annual Meeting and Ultreya at Mt. Gilead State Park. Come and enjoy fellowship with others through worship, games and of course food. Camping is available and maybe golf afterword if there is enough interest. We will gather at 12:00 noon with the potluck to start at 12:30 followed by worship and the Annual Meeting. This is Saturday June 29. On the subject of the Annual Meeting, we will elect an Assistant Lay Director (Christy Brill has another term available) and Treasurer. Raleigh Sandy has served two terms.

## Schedule for COED Weekend #4

### A Message from Sherryl Patterson, VdC Ohio Palanca Coordinator

## <u>Palanca</u>

What an interesting word, but what does it mean or better yet how do you even pronounce it? Let's start at the beginning (Palanca: pah lahnk ah) is a direct word from the Spanish, meaning "lever". In the Via de Cristo, which is also Spanish for 'Way of Christ', Palanca means an outward expression of love through prayer and sacrifice which is offered to God in petition for grace so that as apostles we may accomplish more than we would be capable of otherwise.

This is why we ask communities to fill a space of time with prayer from Thursday evening, May 30<sup>th</sup> until Sunday evening, June 2<sup>nd</sup> to lift up each pilgrim and their families to the grace of God. You will receive the opportunity to choose times in the 72 Hour Prayer Palanca schedule next week.

Prayer is our 'lever' to accomplish all that God wants us to accomplish. There are many types of ways to use prayer; reading scripture, singing songs or psalms, sitting quietly and allowing the spirit to reach into your heart with whatever is comfortable for you.

Lately, I have been using 'Centering Prayer', of which there are four guidelines: 1. Choose a sacred word as the symbol of your intention to consent to God's presence and action within - 2. Sitting comfortably and with eyes closed, settle briefly and silently introduce the sacred word as the symbol of your consent to God's presence and action within - 3. When engaged with your thoughts (body sensations, feelings, images, and reflections), return ever-so-gently to the sacred word - 4. At the end of the prayer period remain in silence with eyes closed for a couple of minutes.

The prayer period can be from 30 minutes to an hour, depending if you sign up for a space of time for the weekend.

Begin with an Opening Prayer

Begin your Prayer time (it would be good to set a timer for you to hear and to know when your prayer time as ended.)

At the end of the prayer period remain in silence with eyes closed for a couple of minutes.

Close with prayer (you can use the Come Holy Spirit prayer, the Lord's Prayer, a favorite Psalm or Scripture, or simply pray what God has placed on your heart!

In closing, I lift up an "Invitation to Love", a prayer from Thomas Keating:

The way of pure faith is to persevere in contemplative practice without worrying about where we are on the journey, and without comparing ourselves with others or judging others' gifts as better than ours. We can be spared all this nonsense if we surrender ourselves to the divine action, whatever the psychological content of our prayer may be. In pure faith, the results are often hidden from those who are growing the most ... The divine light of faith is totally available in the degree that we consent and surrender ourselves to its presence and action within. In Jesus name, Amen.
