February  $1^{*}$  I head to India, where Christianity is sweeping the nation. The Holy Spirit is working and now there are 30,000 Christians for every pastor.

Many Christian leaders who have become deputized as pastors have not had for seminary training, so willing pastors from this country are voluntarily traveling to teach what was given to us in theological training to pass on to others. I will be in Bangalore and Delhi for several weeks. The program is "India Transformed" and works with the United Evangelical Ministries of India.

We request prayers for safety for all those who will be traveling, as well as health and wellness while staying in a populous nation with tremendous potential as well as crushing poverty and deadly diseases.

We also request prayers that the Holy Spirit guide the words, lectures, and sermons shared by stateside pastors.

"'Come, follow me,' Jesus said, 'and I will make you fishers of men.' " Matthew 4:19


"I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile." Romans 1:16

I attend Abiding Christ Lutheran Church in Fairborn, Ohio, serving on the staff as Director of Lay Ministries. The congregation is currently actively supporting worship each Sunday for two services and a Wednesday evening service that provides lay ministry support to the community through outreach to meet the hunger, health, housing, transportation, and benefit counseling needs in the congregation and community.

My reunion group meets every Monday at noon to share our Fourth Day commitment. I left the group for awhile to help get other groups started. I hope these groups will become lasting groups as ours has, existing since the spring of 2003.

My favorite moment during a VDC weekend was shared by my table of Luke when I was a pilgrim. Several men at the table had never had an experience with Christ and became aware of His presence during the weekend. We had to leave the rollo room several times to visit the chapel to pray and comfort our fellow table members. Most of these members have now served on subsequent weekends.

I see a weakness in our effort as leaders to lead and assist our members in their fourth day commitment. I feel there is a need to find a way to follow up with our members supporting their efforts to participate in reunion groups and become accountable to themselves, their congregation, their community, and to the Lord.

I am a retired Air Force officer, a certified tax practitioner, and certified substitute teacher. I am very active in the Boy Scout Program and serve as Vice Chairman on the Central District National Eagle Scout Association Scholarship Committee.

### A Message from VdC Ohio Music Advisor Jen Briner

Lanny Wolfe was born and raised in Columbus Ohio. (Anyone know he was a Buckeye?!!) His mother sang and played guitar in church revivals and that was where Lanny developed his love of music. Not realizing he could make a living as a church musician (he played piano by ear with no formal training), he got his business degree from Ohio State in the 1960's. After college he took a job at the suggestion of a friend teaching music at a Bible College in California. Not feeling adequate to the task, Lanny decided to take some music classes at a local college. In a very short time he graduated, started teaching junior high school music, found out he and his wife were expecting their first child and got drafted to Vietnam one month before his 26<sup>th</sup> birthday (when he would have agedout)! Lanny put his trust in God through this difficult and scary time. He ended up not having to go to war (flat feet and a pregnant wife!) and got a job as the Dean of Music at a Bible College. It was there he met two other musicians and formed "The Lanny Wolfe Trio".

The Trio performed all over the US and it was during this time that Lanny wrote two musicals. He had an idea for a third musical but his publisher was not in agreement about the subject matter. Lanny was instructed to write a Christmas-themed musical instead. There was a song he felt very strongly about, but his publisher felt just as strongly that "he could write a better song". Lanny stuck to his guns and the song, "More Than Wonderful" went on to win a Grammy for Sandi Patty and Larnelle Harris and won Song of the Year in 1984 by the Gospel Music Association.

Now that you have some background, on to how "Surely the Presence" came to be about! The Lanny Wolfe Trio was scheduled to provide the music for the dedication service for a new church auditorium. Before the trio got up to sing, the Lord (in Lanny's words) "dropped a tune and some lyrics in my mind". The strange part about the situation is that the music went in a certain progression that he would not ordinarily go in. But when it was time for the trio to sing, he stepped to the piano and sang through the chorus, just as the Lord gave it him. Next, he taught it to the audience. Lanny then sang the song through completely. This song came to be known as "Surely the Presence" and it has never been changed in any way to this day!
