On Sunday mornings, we are studying Adam Hamilton's Christianity and World Religions. You might remember Pastor Adam has written When Christians get it Wrong. We studied that last year and it was a terrific book. There are so many good books out there – the best being the Bible! Do you read it? I have down loaded it onto my Kindle so I have it with me especially when I travel.

At St. Paul – Sharon Center, we are in the midst of talking about renovations. It sometimes happens when part of your building is over one hundred years old. A book, <u>Ask, Thank and Tell</u> was recommended to us. It really is a book about stewardship, and I have only read the first two chapters but it is awesome!
