I currently attend St Andrew's Anglican Church in Lewis Center, Ohio with my husband Dan Brill, who attended Ohio Men's Weekend #44 also at the Cum Christo Center in April 2001 (the weekend before we were married).

Both Dan & I have been active with Via de Cristo of Ohio since attending our weekends. Personally, I have served on 14 different teams in several different roles, with the most recent being the Leaders professor for Clergy Experience #2 that was held this past October. I had the honor to be called as Rector to VdC-OH Women's #53, and Dan and I have been blessed to be the 4th Day Couple on four different occasions. I attend Abiding Christ Lutheran Church in Fairborn, Ohio, where I serve on the staff as the Director of Lay Ministries. The congregation is currently actively supporting worship each Sunday for two services and a Wednesday evening service that provides lay ministry support to the community through outreach to meet the hunger, health, housing, transportation, and benefit counseling needs in the congregation and community.

My reunion group meets every Monday at noon to break bread and share our fourth day commitment. I left the group for a while to make an effort to get other groups started. Hopefully these groups will develop into lasting groups as our Monday group which has existed since the spring of 2003.

My favorite moment during a VDC weekend was shared by my table of Luke when I was a pilgrim. Several men at the table had never had an experience with Christ and became aware of His presence during the weekend. We had to leave the rollo room several times to visit the chapel to pray and comfort our fellow table members. Most of these members have now served on subsequent weekends.

I see a weakness in our effort as leaders to lead and assist our members in their fourth day commitment. I feel there is a need to find a way to follow up with our members, supporting their efforts to participate in reunion groups and become accountable to themselves, their congregation, their community, and to the Lord.

I am a retired Air Force officer, a certified tax practitioner, and certified substitute teacher. I am very active in the Boy Scout Program and serving as Chairman on the Central District National Eagle Scout Association Scholarship Committee.

Editor's note: The goal of Via de Cristo is to strengthen people of faith and to equip people of faith to share the Good News of Jesus Christ in their environments. That takes on many forms! Most Cursillistas (that means people who've been on a VdC Weekend as Pilgrims) become more active in their churches; many start new groups such as for Bible study or teaching children or serving their community; some boldly witness to strangers on the street or in a store; some become Christian mentors to family members or coworkers.
