

Agree to support the pilgrim through prayer, palanca, and your presence at the closing?		
Agree to actively assist the pilgrim to join a Reunion Group and participate in Ultreya?		
Agree to support the pilgrim in the 4 th day for at least six months after the weekend?		

SPONSOR GUIDELINES

Before you approach your pilgrim:

- 1. The Via de Cristo movement is Christian and provides a renewal opportunity for baptized believers in Jesus Christ. The weekend can be an emotional and deeply spiritual experience and is not suited for everyone. Your pilgrim should be mentally, physically, and spiritually able to experience the weekend completely and must have the endorsement of clergy that knows them well enough to provide such endorsement.
- 2. Clergy endorsement cannot be overemphasized. Check with the endorsing clergy before approaching a prospective pilgrim to ensure endorsement will be forthcoming. Failure to do so can cause serious problems. The clergy may know something about the prospective pilgrim that makes that person unsuitable for a Via de Cristo weekend at the time you approach them. This does not preclude you from approaching that person once the situation is rectified or the clergy is willing to provide endorsement.

When you approach your pilgrim:

3. Once you have clergy concurrence, approach the prospective pilgrim. Answer any questions they may ask. If asked, let the pilgrim know that their weekend has been paid for by those who have gone on previous weekends, by the community, or by the sponsor. Let the pilgrim know that a free-will offering will be received in the spirit of giving. Assist the pilgrim in filling out the Pilgrim's Registration Form to ensure accuracy and completeness.

After your pilgrim agrees to attend:

- 4. Mail the completed Pilgrim's Registration Form and your Sponsor's Registration Form along with a non-refundable \$15 application fee (payable to Via de Cristo of Ohio) to the address below.
- 5. Stay in contact with your pilgrim and give your support. Both you and the pilgrim will receive acknowledgement of registration and instructions for the weekend.
